Rocket Phonics Treasure Hunt #2

Children will have fun reading the clues and finding the treasure in this Rocket Phonics Treasure Hunt. Each clue is two-sided. One side is printed with regular type, and tells you where to hide the clue. The back side has the same clue with Rocket Phonics' unique prompts, or helpers.

Children all ages can join in the hunt. Even if your child is just starting to read, your child can read the clues – if your child has learned the 36 symbols of English from the Rocket Phonics Play & Read cards or the Rocket Phonics kit. Children already reading can just read the side with the plain clue. Your children will love the independence of reading the clues on their own.

What you will need: sticky tape, scissors. Treasure included for four children.

Instructions to the parent or leader:

- 1. Preview all clues before starting. Make sure you have in your hunt area the items named in the clues (for example, a TV, a closet door, and a Yellow Pages book). If you don't have an item, change the clue to an item you do have, such as a radio.
- 2. Notice that the introduction and each clue tell you where to put each clue.
- 3. Cut the clues apart. Depending on the number of children playing, you can split the introduction in two parts or not. Children all like to have an equal number of turns reading, so try to arrange that. If the turns aren't equal, just let them know ahead.
- 4. Hide the clues and treasure where each clue directs. Here is where they go:
 - a. Introduction: hold to give to first reader
 - b. Clue 1: put under telephone
 - c. Clue 2: place under an end table
 - d. Clue 3: place in the laundry
 - e. Clue 4: place under a waste basket on the floor
 - f. Clue 5: tape to a cereal box
 - g. Clue 6: place with tee shirts in a drawer
 - h. Clue 7: tape to a broom
 - i. Clue 8: tape to reader's toothbrush
 - j. Clue 9: tape under the table where you dine
 - k. Clue 10: place under the leg of a living room chair
 - I. Clue 11: place on page seven of the Bible
 - m. Treasure: place under the bed
- 5. Ask your child(ren) to read the clues aloud. You can have them read the clues either with or without helpers (prompting).
